THE POSITION

JOB OVERVIEW

The Skidder Operator operates a rubber-tired grapple machine which moves through the forest to pull felled trees, to the landing area, where those trees are processed for delivery.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 0-3 years' experience operating Skidder
- Demonstrated ability on safe skidding and service performance
- Must be a US citizen
- Valid driver's license

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Operate skidder to drag trees to landing area
- Perform multiple inspections throughout day on equipment to check and maintain proper fluid levels, performance of the equipment, etc.
- Report equipment needs and hazards to Supervisor
- Survey, evaluate and take measures to ensure work area is safe from any dangers (power lines, utilities, co-workers, etc.)
- Inspect all attachments to the machinery to ensure that they are operational and take the appropriate steps to correct
- Follow work order instructions from Supervisor
- Ensures that job site is left in safe condition
- Perform other duties as assigned

Required Skills and Abilities:

- Ability to understand and follow oral instructions; communicate with supervisors, co-workers and the public effectively
- Able to comply with all company policies and procedures
- Ability to travel and work overtime when required
- Must have strong work ethic
- Able to push and pull with hands, arms, and feet repetitively
- Must have good visual and auditory physical capabilities to manage sights and sounds in a hazardous work environment
